Introduction

This index replaces the shorter index in Ralph Hanna's *Descriptive Catalogue of the Medieval Manuscripts in St John's College Oxford* (Oxford, 2002).

Where applicable, the name headings match those used in the *Medieval Manuscripts in Oxford Libraries* online catalogue. For clarity, the prefix 'pseudo-' is used here as such before the respective names rather than being added to the end of the author statement. To facilitate identification, the year of birth and/or death or similar is always be added to names. Prepositions such as 'de', 'of' etc. which are part of names are ignored in the alphabetical listing. Although some cross references are provided, no attempt has been made to include all name variants.

Titles in italics match those used in *Medieval Manuscripts in Oxford Libraries* where applicable. The titles used reflect the languages of the texts unless noted otherwise in square brackets.

As in the printed catalogue arabic numerals in parentheses indicate main texts while Latin letters in parentheses indicate added texts.

General subjects headings are marked by a light blue background. General categories/ genres of texts are marked by a light green background.
